Contributions to RPAC are not deductible for Federal Income Tax purposes. Contributions to RPAC are voluntary and used for political purposes. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal. 70% of each contribution is used by Arkansas RPAC to support state and local political candidates. Of this portion, up to \$25 will be applied toward ARPACII, the balance will be applied toward ARPAC. Thirty percent of each contribution, and any portion of the 70% described above in excess of \$1,000, is sent to national RPAC to support Federal candidates and is charged against your limits under 2 U.S.C. 441a.
